Minutes

2. Finance Report

Alysia presented an update on the current finance position. We are on track in terms of expenditure and income is forecast to be slightly hight as we have more members than expected. The defunct at the end of the year is likely to be around £200.

Paul asked that we amend the Finance Policy to state that reserves must be 2.5 times the annual budget. The current level ion $\pounds1,000$ is too low considering the liabilities we have with regards to training slots. The committee agreed.

Action: Paul to update Finance Policy

<u>2.1 New kit</u>

Sportsway are delivering the new NVL kit next week and Sarah will order the regional and local league kit. Twelve of the NVL shirts were free (due to errors by Sportsway) and the club paid for 3 spare shirts. Paul to order a set of 6 volleyballs.

Action: Sarah to order local and regional league kit from Sportsway once she has confirmation from the captains.

Action: Paul to order 6 balls from Sportset.

2.2 Additional training slots

The Wednesday evening slots are becoming very busy as we have over a dozen juniors attending as well as the local league players. Paul asked New College and the Arena if they had other slots but only New College had anything, which was 2 hours on a Saturday morning. Only 1 or 2 from local league can make that slot and the reaction from the junior group was mixed. Paul will review in a couple of weeks time.

2.3 New bank account and CIC

Paul and Alysia have been waiting until the new year is out of the way but will meet soon to investigate creating a Community Interest Company to create greater structure for the club.

3 Safeguarding

Paul has raised an incident related to poor practice from a parent and it is being logged. Sam to review and determine what action to take.

4. Squad Updates

<u>4.1 NVL</u>

The NVL team are currently lying 6th out of 9. It was always going to be a year of consolidation after reaching Div 2 and the team are playing well and have been unlucky not to turn around a couple of tight sets. Sarah is trying to organise another scrimmage game against DMU.

4.2 Regional

The Regional league team have won 6 matches out of 8, which is a huge improvement on last year. The squad have settled into a solid group of 9 players.

<u>4.3 Local</u>

The local league team have played 4 matches and not won a set. However, they are still very inexperienced and are improving as individuals and as a team. The standard of play is showing some real promise for the future.

4.4 Juniors

We are currently getting around 12 juniors to training, racing from 11 years to 17 years old. Eli has been helping out coaching the juniors and the atmosphere is fabulous.

5 Future Plans

5.1 Teams for 2020-21

It is hoped that we move from 3 to 5 teams next season to give players better opportunities to play and develop. Ideally, we will have a junior team that can complete in the local league plus a Div 3 team with DMU to the regional league players to make the step up and to allow DMU players to gain NVL experience.

A lot of factors have to be considered before then, not least our relationship with DMU.

Action: Paul to contact Ryan at DMU for a catch up, as he is about leave for a new role.

5.2 Coaches

With the increase in teams and the increase in juniors, the club needs more coaches. Currently, the following coaches are involved:

- NVL Gordon MacDonald (assisted by Roland)
- Regional Paul Kaerger (assisted by Sarah)
- · Local/Juniors Paul Kaerger (assisted by Eli)

Paul feels that we need to identify/develop 5 coaches to support the club's growth.

5.3 Court Time

Paul explained that court time remains a major constraint. Very few schools seem to have sports halls that have the right level of volleyball equipment (specifically, anchor points for quality posts) and those all seem to be booked out.

Kristy said that Sunday mornings are difficult for many NVL players and asked if New College have availability in the early evening, after the regional league team's training session.

Action: Paul to ask New College for availability on Sunday evenings

6.1 Junior outing

Sabine is going to organise another junior social event, likely to be to Treetops Golf

6.2 Social Events

Kristy is planning to organise an end of year event for the AGM, awards and social event.

7. Summer Tournaments

7.1 Athena Summer Tournament

Charlie is going to lead the planning of this again. DMU may be able to offer a venue at a more competitive price than University of Leicester.
